Alberta Children's Hospital unveils future patient rooms

The Alberta Children's Hospital Project Office has created three mock-up rooms to show how the new hospital's facilities will look and function once the hospital is completed. The full-sized inpatient room, emergency trauma room and pediatric intensive care room include all the furniture, colors and features that will be incorporated into the new rooms.

"This is a great opportunity to see what these rooms will look like in the new hospital with all their new features," says Brenda Fischer, Vice President of the Child & Women's Health Portfolio at Alberta Children's Hospital. "We have had lots of input from parents and children so we could create something that was functional and as pleasant as possible to spend time in."

The hospital, which is scheduled to open three months ahead of schedule in August 2006, will be located in the city's northwest on the University of Calgary's West Campus. The new Alberta Children's Hospital will be approximately 50% larger than the current hospital.
