

WHAT TO BRING

- Loose comfortable clothes for your child to wear home
- A housecoat/zip-up hoodie and warm socks/slippers to wear with hospital pajamas
- An extra set of clothes
- Contact lenses case and solution
- A comfort item to take into the operating room (toy, blanket or stuffed animal)
- Toys, books, games, headphones, DVD movies or portable music players
- Any special medications including inhalers, insulin, heart or seizure medications
- Medical supplies needed for things like G-tube feedings, trach care, or diabetes
- Any special bottle, nipple or sippy cup your child likes to use for after surgery
- A container or plastic re-sealable bag for the drive home
- Your child's Alberta Health card

If your child is **staying overnight** or longer, also bring:

- Toothpaste and toothbrush
- Shampoo/conditioner
- Brush/comb
