



IN THE MATTER OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT – ALBERTA
ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Re: The water supply located in the Municipal District of Foothills, Alberta and municipally described as:

Riverbend Campground
NW ¼ 23-20-29 W5M
Municipal District of Foothills, Alberta

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of the **Calgary Health Region**, have inspected the above noted water supply pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist regarding the above noted water supply which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Water in the distribution system may be unsafe for human consumption as indicated by the presence of total coliforms in drinking water samples collected on July 16, 2007, July 23, 2007, July 30 2007 and August 20, 2007.
- b. Water in the distribution system may be groundwater under the influence of surface water and there is no water treatment in place.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation, Alberta Regulation 243/2003, exist in and about the above noted water supply, namely:

- a. Water in the distribution system may be unsafe for human consumption as indicated by the presence of total coliforms in drinking water samples collected on July 16, 2007, July 23, 2007, July 30 2007 and August 20, 2007, is a contravention of Section 11, which states:

Where a person provides a source of water that the person intends to be used or realizes or ought to realize will be used by the public for human consumption, the person shall ensure that the water is potable.

- b. Water in the distribution system may be groundwater under the influence of surface water and there is no water treatment in place, is a contravention of Section 11,

which states:

Where a person provides a source of water that the person intends to be used or realizes or ought to realize will be used by the public for human consumption, the person shall ensure that the water is potable.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following steps and work in and about the above noted water supply, namely:
 - a. Post boil water advisory signs that have been issued by Calgary Health Region next to all water fixtures accessible to the public. These signs must remain in place until the drinking water is deemed safe for human consumption by an executive officer of the Calgary Health Region.
 - b. Submit water samples for bacteriological analysis on a weekly basis until instructed otherwise by an executive officer of the Calgary Health Region.
 - c. Prepare a detailed proposal outlining the upgrades and/or alterations to the water system necessary to ensure a potable water supply along with schedules completion dates and submit to the Calgary Health Region for review by January 31, 2008.
 - d. Complete all of the necessary upgrades and/or alterations to the water system to ensure each connection is serviced with a potable water supply by May 1, 2008.
2. That, until such time as the work referred to in paragraph 1 is completed and the water supply is shown to be potable to the satisfaction of the undersigned, or an executive officer of the Calgary Health Region, that this order shall remain in effect.

Section 5(2) of the Public Health Act provides that a person who is directly affected by this Order and considers himself or herself aggrieved hereby may appeal the same to the Public Health Appeal Board, 24th Floor, Telus Plaza North Tower, 10025 Jasper Avenue, Edmonton AB T5J 2N3, within ten (10) days. The terms of this Order remain in effect notwithstanding the filing or proposed filing of any such appeal.

The Owner is advised that the Public Health Act empowers the Calgary Health Region to carry out the terms of this Order on the Owner's behalf and at the Owner's expense should the Owner fail to comply with the terms hereof.
