

IN THE MATTER OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT – ALBERTA
ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

To: Elkana Residents Water Co-Operative Limited

(the “**Owner**”)

Re: The Drinking Water Supply located in Bragg Creek, Alberta and municipally described as:

Elkana Residents Water Co-Operative Limited
S-13-23-5-5
Bragg Creek, MD of Rocky View, Alberta

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of the **Calgary Health Region**, have inspected the above noted Drinking Water Supply pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted Drinking Water Supply which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Water treatment is not sufficient to render the water safe for human consumption.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation, Alberta Regulation 243/2003 exist in and about the above noted Drinking Water Supply, namely:

- a. Water treatment is not sufficient to render the water safe for human consumption.

AND WHEREAS by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted Source of Water is hereby declared **unfit for human consumption**;

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner inform all users of the active Boil Water Advisory for the Elkana Residents Water Co-Operative to heat water to a rolling boil for one minute or distil water, prior to any consumptive use including teeth brushing.
2. That the Owner undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted Drinking Water Supply, namely:

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Re: The Drinking Water System known as Elkana Residents Water Co-operative located in Bragg Creek, MD of Rocky View Alberta and municipally described as S-13-23-5-5, Alberta

- a. Install a surface water treatment plant prior to November 30, 2009
3. That, until such time as the work referred to in paragraph 2 is completed and the Source of Water is shown to be potable to the satisfaction of the undersigned, or an executive officer of the Calgary Health Region, that this order shall remain in effect.

Section 5(2) of the Public Health Act provides that a person who is directly affected by this Order and considers himself or herself aggrieved hereby may appeal the same to the Public Health Appeal Board, 24th Floor, Telus Plaza North Tower, 10025 Jasper Avenue, Edmonton AB T5J 2N3, within ten (10) days. The terms of this Order remain in effect notwithstanding the filing or proposed filing of any such appeal.

The Owner is advised that the Public Health Act empowers the Calgary Health Region to carry out the terms of this Order on the Owner's behalf and at the Owner's expense should the Owner fail to comply with the terms hereof.
