

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

To: Exshaw Community Association
(The "Owner")

RE: The food establishment located in Exshaw, Alberta and municipally described as:
Exshaw Community Ball Diamond, NE 23-24-9-W5M

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Drinking water sample taken on May 27, 2011 was positive for total coliforms. Drinking water samples taken on May 30, 2011 and July 4, 2011 had total coliform counts of more than 201 per 100mL. Drinking water sample taken on August 8, 2011 was positive for total coliforms. Drinking water sample taken on August 15, 2011 had a total coliform count of 95 per 100mL. Drinking water sample taken on August 22, 2011 was positive for total coliforms.
- b. No handsink present in the kitchen/food preparation area

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted food establishment, namely:

- a. Drinking water sample taken on May 27, 2011 was positive for total coliforms. Drinking water samples taken on May 30, 2011 and July 4, 2011 had total coliform counts of more than 201 per 100mL. Drinking water sample taken on August 8, 2011 was positive for total coliforms. Drinking water sample taken on August 15, 2011 had a total coliform count of 95 per 100mL. Drinking water sample taken on August 22, 2011 was positive for total coliforms. This is in contravention of the Food Regulation Section 17(10)(f)(i).
- b. No handsink present in the kitchen/food preparation area. This is in contravention of the Food Regulation Section 17(1)(e).

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted food establishment, namely:
 - a. Post signage at each water tap in the premises that the water must be boiled prior to consumption or use in food preparation.
 - b. Provide hand sanitizer in each bathroom and at the two compartment sink in the kitchen/food preparation area for patrons to use after washing their hands.
 - c. Install an approved potable water system.

- d. Install a handwashing sink equipped with hot and cold running water in the kitchen/food preparation area.
2. The work referred to in paragraph 1, items a and b, shall be completed immediately and the work referred to in paragraph 1, items c and d, shall be completed before opening for the season of 2012 and/or by May 1, 2012.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO APPEAL

A person who a) is directly affected by a decision of a Regional Health Authority, and
b) feels himself aggrieved by the decision

may appeal the decision within ten (10) days after receiving the order to the Public Health Appeal Board located at 24th Floor, Telus Plaza, 10025 - Jasper Avenue, Edmonton, Alberta, T5J 1S6. Telephone (780) 427-2813.

The terms of this Order remain in effect notwithstanding the filing or proposed filing of any such appeal. If you appeal, you may also make an application to the Board for a stay of this Order pending the appeal.
