

IN THE MATTER OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT – ALBERTA
ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

(the “**Owner**”)

Re: The Hot Dog Vending Vehicle known as All Dogs Allowed located in Calgary, Alberta and inspected at the Heritage Day Festival at Prince’s Island Park

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted Hot Dog Vending Vehicle pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted hot dog vending vehicle which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. There is a lack of water from the plumbing fixture due to a faulty water pump.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted food establishment, namely:

- a. There is a lack of water from the plumbing fixture due to a faulty water pump. This is in contravention to Section 17(1)(f)(i) of the Food Regulation.

AND WHEREAS by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **closed**;

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately **close** the above noted food establishment
2. That the Owner undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted food establishment, namely:
 - a. Conduct all necessary repairs to the plumbing system to provide sufficient hot and cold water at suitable pressure at all times.
3. That, until such time as the work referred to in paragraph 2 is completed to the satisfaction of the undersigned, or an executive officer of Alberta Health Services, the above noted premises shall remain closed.

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

The terms of this Order remain in effect notwithstanding the filing or proposed filing of any such appeal.

The Owner is advised that the Public Health Act empowers Alberta Health Services to carry out the terms of this Order on the Owner's behalf and at the Owner's expense should the Owner fail to comply with the terms hereof.
