

**IN THE MATTER OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT – ALBERTA**  
**ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER**

**Re:** The Food Establishment located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as:

**Dog Father's #00178**  
213 10<sup>th</sup> Ave, SW  
Calgary, Alberta

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted Food Establishment pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted food establishment which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. There was no supply of hot water to the cart;
- b. Food contact surfaces were not being properly cleaned & sanitized as there was no hot water or sanitizer available;
- c. Containers full of onions were not protected from contamination and were dirty;
- d. Condiment containers were dirty and had accumulation of old foods/condiments;
- e. There was no wastewater tank;
- f. Staff member on site did not have sufficient food safety training or knowledge;
- g. No water samples from the holding tank have been submitted to the Provincial Laboratory of Public Health since September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted food establishment, namely:

- a. There was no supply of hot water to the cart. This is in contravention of Section 17(1)(f)(i) of the Food Regulation;

- b. Food contact surfaces were not being properly cleaned & sanitized as there was no hot water or sanitizer available. This is in contravention of Section 28(2) of the Food Regulation;
- c. Containers full of onions were not protected from contamination and were dirty. This is in contravention of Section 3.5 of the Food Retail and Foodservices Code;
- d. Condiment containers were dirty and had accumulation of old foods/condiments. This is in contravention of Section 4.2.4 of the Food Retail and Foodservices Code;
- e. There was no wastewater tank. This is in contravention of Section 17 (1) of the Food Regulation and Section 2.11 (b) of the Food Retail and Foodservices Code;
- f. Staff member on site did not have sufficient food safety training or knowledge. This is in contravention of Section 5.1 of the Food Retail and Foodservices Code.
- g. No water samples from the holding tank have been submitted to the Provincial Laboratory of Public Health since September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009. This is in contravention of Section 2.10(c) of the Alberta Food Retail and Foodservices Code.

AND WHEREAS by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **CLOSED**;

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately **CLOSE** the above noted food establishment
2. That the Owner undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted food establishment, namely:
  - a. Restore an adequate supply of hot water to the cart. Hot water must be available at all times while the cart is in operation;
  - b. Thoroughly clean and sanitize all the food contact surfaces on the cart. Thereafter, all food contact surfaces must be washed, rinsed, and sanitized;
  - c. All food storage containers must be protected from contamination. The food storage containers must be washed, rinsed and sanitized after each use;
  - d. All condiment containers must be washed, rinsed and sanitized after each day of operation;
  - e. A wastewater tank must be present at all times during operation. The wastewater tank must be enclosed and at least as big as the water supply tank;
  - f. All staff that operate the cart will have completed 2.5 hour food safety training course provided by Alberta Health Services. Call 403-943-2290 to register in the classroom course;
  - g. A water sample from water in holding tank of this mobile hot dog cart must be submitted to the Provincial Laboratory of Public Health.
3. That, until such time as the work referred to in paragraph 2 (a) to (g) is completed to the satisfaction of the undersigned, or an executive officer of Alberta Health Services, and a water sample submitted under 2 (g) is shown to be satisfactory, the above noted premises shall remain closed.
