Re: The Food Establishment located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as:

Shawarma King

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted Food Establishment pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted food establishment which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Donair meat, chicken and beef were found on their respective cooking spits with the heating systems for each turned off. The surface temperatures of these perishable food items were recorded at or around 22 Celsius and the internal temperatures were recorded at or around 30 Celsius.
- b. The floor below the cooking equipment and the food preparation area cooler had an accumulation of dirt and debris.
- c. The areas behind and beside the cooking equipment had an accumulation of dirt and debris.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted food establishment, namely:

- a. Donair meat, chicken and beef were found on their respective cooking spits with the heating systems for each turned off. The surface temperatures of these perishable food items were recorded at or around 22 Celsius and the internal temperatures were recorded at or around 30 Celsius contravening sections 2(6), 24 and 25(1) of the Regulation and sections 3.3.4 and 3.3.5 of the Code.
- b. The floor below the cooking equipment and the food preparation area cooler had an accumulation of dirt and debris contravening section 28(2) of the Regulation.
- c. The areas behind and beside the cooking equipment had an accumulation of dirt and debris contravening section 28(2) of the Regulation.

AND WHEREAS by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **closed**;

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately **close** the above noted food establishment
2. That the Owner undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted food establishment, namely:
 - a. Develop and implement a written procedure for food preparation staff detailing the correct and safe procedures for handling, preparing, cooking and serving perishable foods within the food establishment.
 - b. Ensure that all food preparation staff within the food establishment are aware of and follow safe cooking procedures for perishable foods that require cooking.
 - c. Demonstrate that safe procedures as noted above can be carried out by staff on a daily basis.
 - d. Clean and sanitize the food preparation areas.
3. That, until such time as the work referred to in paragraph 2 is completed to the satisfaction of the undersigned, or an executive officer of Alberta Health Services, the above noted premises shall remain closed.

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

The terms of this Order remain in effect notwithstanding the filing or proposed filing of any such appeal.

The Owner is advised that the Public Health Act empowers Alberta Health Services to carry out the terms of this Order on the Owner's behalf and at the Owner's expense should the Owner fail to comply with the terms hereof.
