

**IN THE MATTER OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT – ALBERTA**  
**ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER**

(the “**Owner**”)

**Re:** The Food Establishment located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as:

**Larosh Caters**  
33-4525 52 St. N.E.  
Calgary, Alberta

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted Food Establishment pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted food establishment which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Heavy accumulation of mouse droppings found on floor edges in kitchen and back storage areas.
- b. No sanitizer readily available during operation.
- c. Both inner and outer sides of the chest freezer lid are badly damaged.
- d. Metal shelves inside walk-in cooler are rusty and cannot be cleaned properly
- e. Plastic cutting board is worn with deep and blackened cut marks.
- f. Microwave oven door is taped with greasy and dirt duct tape.
- g. Rubber seal along the walk-in cooler door is melted with grease and dirt.
- h. Heavy accumulation of grease and dirt is found under all shelves, tables, pot sinks, and carts.
- i. All milk crates are covered with grease and dirt.
- j. Wooden pallets under dough mixer and chest freezer have heavy build up of wet and blackened flour.

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Re: The Food Establishment, Larosh Caters, located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as 33-4525 36 St NE,  
Calgary, Alberta

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- k. Yellowish stagnant water left in hot holding unit for days.
- l. Poor general sanitation.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted food establishment, namely:

- a. Heavy accumulation of mouse droppings found on floor edges in kitchen and back storage areas which is a breach of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 section 21(1);
- b. No sanitizer available in a pail or in a spray bottle which is a breach of Food Regulation AR 31/2006 section 28(2) and Alberta Food Retail and Foodservices Code 2003 section 4.2.5(a);
- c. Both inner and outer sides of the chest freezer lid are badly damaged which is a breach of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 section 28(3);
- d. Metal shelves inside walk-in cooler are rusty and cannot be cleaned properly which is a breach of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 section 28(3);
- e. Plastic cutting board is worn with deep and blackened cut marks which is a breach of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 section 28(3);
- f. Microwave oven door is taped with greasy and dirt duct tape which is a breach of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 section 28(3);
- g. Rubber seal along the walk-in cooler door is melted with grease and dirt which is a breach of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 section 28(3);
- h. Heavy accumulation of grease and dirt is found under all shelves, tables, pot sinks, and carts which is a breach of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 section 28(2);
- i. All milk crates are covered with grease and dirt which is a breach of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 section 28(2);
- j. Wooden pallets under dough mixer and chest freezer have heavy build up of wet and blackened flour which is a breach of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 section 28(3);
- k. Yellowish stagnant water left in hot holding unit for days which is a breach of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 section 28(2), (3);
- l. Poor general sanitation which is a breach of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 section 28(2);

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AND WHEREAS by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **closed**;

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately close the above noted food establishment
2. That the Owner undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted food establishment, namely:
  - a. Clean up all mouse droppings, remove items that provide harbourage. Thoroughly clean and sanitize all food contact surfaces and kitchen shelves. Monitor mouse infestation using monitoring mouse traps.
  - b. Ensure a prepared solution of sanitizer is present at all times of facility operation.
  - c. Clean and paint the top surface of the chest freezer lid. Conceal insulation material in the inner side of the chest freezer lid.
  - d. Clean and paint the metal shelves in the walk-in cooler.
  - e. Replace or repair the plastic cutting board.
  - f. Remove duct tape from microwave oven.
  - g. Remove and repair rubber seal along the walk-in cooler door.
  - h. Thoroughly clean the floor under all shelves, tables, pot sinks, and carts.
  - i. Thoroughly clean all the milk crates.
  - j. Thoroughly clean the pallets under dough mixer and chest freezer.
  - k. Thoroughly clean and dry the hot holding unit.
  - l. Provide a cleaning schedule and maintain the premise in a clean and sanitary state hereafter.
3. That, until such time as the work referred to in paragraph 2 is completed to the satisfaction of the undersigned, or an executive officer of Alberta Health Services, the above noted premises shall remain closed.

***Section 5(2) of the Public Health Act provides that a person who is directly affected by this Order and considers himself or herself aggrieved hereby may appeal the same to the Public Health Appeal Board, 24<sup>th</sup> Floor, Telus Plaza North Tower, 10025 Jasper Avenue, Edmonton AB T5J 2N3, within ten (10) days. The terms of this Order remain in effect notwithstanding the filing or proposed filing of any such appeal.***

***The Owner is advised that the Public Health Act empowers Alberta Health Services to carry out the terms of this Order on the Owner's behalf and at the Owner's expense should the Owner fail to comply with the terms hereof.***
