

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE

RE: The food establishment located in Claresholm, Alberta and municipally described as:

7-11 Inc. Store #16963
4701 - 1 Street West
Claresholm, Alberta

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Premises flooded with water from a water line break,
- b. No electrical power ;
- c. No water pressure;
- d. Coolers and freezers not operating.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted food establishment, namely:

- a. Premises flooded with water from a water line break. This contravenes Section 17(1)(a) of the Food Regulation;
- b. No electrical power. This contravenes Section 17(1)(a) and Section 17(1)(f)(iii) of the Food Regulation;
- c. No water pressure. This contravenes Section 17(1)(f)(i) of the Food Regulation;
- d. Coolers and freezers not operating. This contravenes Section 18(b)(ii), Section 25(1) & Section 25(2) of the Food Regulation.

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately **close** the above noted food establishment.

2. That the owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Repair the cause of the water entering the premises;
 - b. Restore hot and cold water under pressure that is safe for human consumption and available in quantities to meet the needs of this food premises;
 - c. Restore electrical power service to this food premises,
 - d. Discard all high-risk food that has a temperature of greater than 4 degrees Celsius or less than 60 degrees Celsius;
 - e. Discard all food that has been contaminated by flood water;
 - f. Thoroughly clean and disinfect all the floors and equipment;
 - g. Thoroughly clean and sanitize all food preparation counters, utensils and food service equipment.

3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted food establishment shall remain closed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO APPEAL

A person who a) is directly affected by a decision of a Regional Health Authority, and
b) feels himself aggrieved by the decision

may appeal the decision within ten (10) days after receiving the order to the Public Health Appeal Board located at 24th Floor, Telus Plaza, 10025 - Jasper Avenue, Edmonton, Alberta, T5J 1S6 Telephone (780) 427-2813.

The terms of this Order remain in effect notwithstanding the filing or proposed filing of any such appeal. If you appeal, you may also make an application to the Board for a stay of this Order pending the appeal.
