

## **ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE**

**To:**           **Sheila Marie Shire**  
**(the “Owner”)**

**RE:**           The personal services facility located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as:  
**Angels Esthetics Boutique**  
**514 54 Avenue SW**  
**Calgary, AB**

**WHEREAS** I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. There is no stainless steel hand wash/equipment decontamination sink dedicated to the personal service areas.
- b. There is a dirty carpet on the floor in both personal service areas.
- c. The personal service areas are not separate from living area. The owner’s dog is allowed in the personal service areas; there are dog beds in both service areas.
- d. The work surfaces in waxing area are covered with dirty cloth towels that are not being changed regularly.
- e. The leather dryer on the manicure station is in disrepair and can not be cleaned and disinfected adequately.
- f. The sheets used for clients’ bed are not being changed after each use.
- g. Re-usable implements are not being cleaned and disinfected adequately between clients.
- h. Both Virox and T36 disinfectants for re-usable implements are expired.
- i. Re-using single use files and buffers.
- j. Antiseptic solution is not being used on skin before pedicure or waxing.
- k. There is no sharp container for razor blades.
- l. There is clutter in both personal service areas.
- m. Used/dirty items found stored amongst new/clean items thought, e.g. nail files, roller tops for body wax bottles.
- n. Surfaces in personal service area are dirty throughout.
- o. Washroom for client use is dirty.
- p. Personal items, e.g. contact solution stored amongst personal service tools and equipment.
- q. Laundry room is cluttered and disorganized.
- r. Clean and dirty items for personal services are not clearly separated. Tools and equipment are not stored in a manner to prevent contamination.

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Personal Services Regulation, Alberta Regulation 20/2003 exist in and about the above noted personal services facility, namely:

- a. There is no stainless steel hand wash/decontamination sink dedicated to the personal service areas. This is in contravention of Section 4(1) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- b. There is a dirty carpet on the floor in both personal service areas. This is in contravention of Section 3(b) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- c. The personal service areas are not separate from living areas. The owner's dog is allowed in the personal service area; there are dog beds in both service areas. This is in contravention of Section 3(b) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- d. The work surfaces are covered with dirty cloth towels that are not being changed regularly. This is in contravention of Section 3(b)(h) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- e. The leather dryer on the manicure station is in disrepair and can not be cleaned and disinfected adequately. This is in contravention of Section 6(1) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- f. The sheets used for client's bed are not being changed after each use. This is in contravention of Section 6(1) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- g. Re-usable implements are not being cleaned and disinfected adequately between clients. This is in contravention of Section 6(2) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- h. Both Virox and T36 disinfectants for re-usable implements are expired. This is in contravention of Section 6(2) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- i. Re-using single use files and buffers. This is in contravention of Section 6(1) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- j. Antiseptic solution is not being used on skin before pedicure and waxing. This is in contravention of Health Standards and Guidelines for Esthetics Section 10.
- k. There is no sharp container for razor blades. This is in contravention of Section 3(e) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- l. There is clutter in both personal service areas. This is in contravention of Section 3(b) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- m. Used/dirty items found stored amongst new/clean items thought, e.g. nail files, roller tops for body wax bottles. This is in contravention of Section 6(1) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- n. Surfaces in personal service area are dirty throughout. This is in contravention of Section 3(b) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- o. Washroom for client use is dirty. This is in contravention of Section 3(b) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- p. Personal items, e.g. contact solution stored amongst personal service tools and equipment. This is in contravention of Section 3(g) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- q. Laundry room is cluttered and disorganized. This is in contravention of Section 3(b) of the Personal Services Regulation.
- r. Clean and dirty items for personal services are not clearly separated. Tools and equipment are not stored in a manner to prevent contamination. This is in contravention of Section 3(b)(g) of the Personal Services Regulation.

**AND WHEREAS**, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately close the above noted premises.
2. That the owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
  - a. Obtain a health approval from Alberta Health Services.
  - b. Install a stainless steel sink with hot and cold running water, soap and paper towels in a dispenser, in the personal service area designated just for the business.
  - c. Remove the carpet and install smooth, easily cleanable flooring.
  - d. Remove the dog beds and prevent the dog from entering the personal service areas.
  - e. Remove the cloth towels from the waxing area. Clean and disinfect the surfaces after each client.
  - f. Obtain a new dryer that can be cleaned and disinfected adequately after each client.
  - g. Change the bed sheets after each client.
  - h. Re-usable implements must be cleaned first and then disinfected with an approved intermediate level disinfectant after each use.
  - i. Obtain new approved disinfectant.
  - j. Immediately after use, dispose of all single use disposable items (eg. files, buffers).
  - k. Use antiseptic solution on skin before waxing and pedicure.
  - l. Obtain a sharp container for storing razor blades.
  - m. Remove all the unnecessary and personal items from the personal service areas.
  - n. Thoroughly clean the client washroom.
  - o. Clean and organize the laundry room.
  - p. Thoroughly clean all surfaces throughout including drawers and storage cabinets.
  - q. Store all tools and equipment in a clean and organized manner that ensures they are protected from contamination.
3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted premises shall remain closed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.

The terms of this Order remain in effect notwithstanding the filing or proposed filing of any such appeal. If you appeal, you may also make an application to the Board for a stay of this Order pending the appeal.
