



IN THE MATTER OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT – ALBERTA
ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Re: The social care facility located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as:
Child Enrichment Centre

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of the **Calgary Health Region**, have inspected the above noted Social Care Facility pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted social care facility which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The overflow in the toilets due to a problem in the community service line affected by rain and flooding.
- b. The inaccessibility of hand wash basins due to advice from the City crew to not use the facilities until the above problem has been resolved.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act, the Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation, Alberta Regulation 243/2003 and the Institutions Regulation, Alberta Regulation 143/1981 exist in and about the above noted social care facility, namely:

- a. The overflow in the toilets due to a problem in the community service line affected by rain and flooding. This is in contravention of section 6 of the Institutions Regulation, Alberta Regulation 143/81 which states *“The land and premises used in whole or in part as an institution shall be of such construction and in such state of repair that it does not create a hazard to the safe and sanitary operation of the institution.”*
- b. The inaccessibility of hand wash basins due to advised from the City crew to not use the facilities until the above problem has been resolved. This is in contravention of
 - i. Section 30(b) of the Institutions Regulation, Alberta Regulation 143/81 which states *“In every day care facility where children under 19 months of age are cared for*
 - *A surface or change table for diapering shall be provided separate from food preparation and food service areas and adjacent to hand*

- washing facilities that is acceptable to the local board.”*
- ii. Section 127 of the Institutions Regulation, Alberta Regulation 143/81 which states “Every institution and day care facility accommodating more than 10 persons shall provide facilities in accordance with the *Provincial Board of Health Regulations Respecting Restaurants* (Alta. Reg. 399/70).”
 - Food Regulation (Alta. Reg. 31/2006), Section 17(1) An operator must ensure that, before operation of the commercial food establishment commences, the commercial food establishment (e) has handwashing stations that are adequate in number and situated so as to ensure convenient access by all food handlers,

AND WHEREAS by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises is hereby declared to be **closed**;

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner **immediately close** the above premises and secure it from unauthorized entry.
2. That the Owner undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Determine the conditions of the premises that have led to the overflowing of the toilets.
 - b. Correct the conditions determined to have led to the overflowing of the toilets.
 - c. Clean and sanitize areas affected by the overflow.
 - d. Allow access and use of the hand wash basins once the repairs are complete.
3. That until such time as the work referred to in paragraph 2 is completed to the satisfaction of the undersigned, or an executive officer of the Calgary Health Region, the above noted social care facility shall remain closed and secured from unauthorized entry.

The terms of this Order remain in effect notwithstanding the filing or proposed filing of any such appeal.

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The Owner is advised that the Public Health Act empowers the Calgary Health Region to carry out the terms of this Order on the Owner's behalf and at the Owner's expense should the Owner fail to comply with the terms hereof.
